The Eighth account of S. M. Janney, surviving Executor of Phineas Janney, deceased, was stated and returned by your Commissioners to the October Term 1860, of the Court. An item of \$372.60 loss on the sale of certain Corporation of Alexandria stock, was reported by your Commr. on the ground that the Executors invested without authority the estate funds in said stocks, notwithstanding the said investments were made in consequence of the pendency of a suit which prevented the Executors from dividing the funds and hand among the legates. The said account was recommended

an exception, with instructions to credit the Executors with the said sum of \$372.00, if Commr. be satisfied that the stock were disposed of at best rate at time of sale. Your Commr. - being entirely satisfied that said stocks were disposed of at their highest marketable value at the time of sale, has in the account herewith returned, obeyed the instructions of the Court and credited the Executor with the said sum of \$372.00 leaving in his hands due to the estate, on 1st of June, 1860, the sum of - \$7563.36. of which sum \$2199.80 is interest.
