I, Joanna Markley, of the City of Alexandria, in the State of Virginia,

being infirm in body, but of sound and disposing mind and memory, do make this my last Will and Testament, revoking all Wills heretofore made by me.

I give, devise, and bequeath, all my property of every kind and description unto Isaac Buckingham and William B. Rice, of the said City of Alexandria, to be held by them, in trust for the following uses and purposes, to wit: One half of such property after payment of my funeral expenses, and of any debts owing by me, should there be any, to be held by them in trust, for the use of my daughter Susan Littlefield, with power to her to make any disposition thereof she pleased. The other half of such property to be held by them in trust for the sole and separate use of my daughter Mary Dearborn the wife of Geo. W. Dearborn during his life, free from the control and liabilities of her husband, and upon her death, for the use of her children the said Mary, to be equally divided among them;
