Your commissioner reports to the Court, that on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1869 Richard L. Smith Trustee of Hugh L. Smith Jr. exhibited before your commissioner a statement of all the moneys which he the said Richard L. Smith had received or become chargeable with, or had disbursed, within the year ending 31<sup>st</sup> December 1868, together with the vouchers for such disbursements, and that your commissioner embraced the said Trustee in the list of Fiduciaries, whose accounts were before him for settlement, which was posted at the front door of the Courthouse of said County, on the first day of March Court last; and on the date of this Report, ten days having elapsed since the said account was mentioned in said list, I made up and completed the annexed account of the said Richard L. Your commissioner reports to the Court that he has examined whether the said Guardian has given such bond as the law requires, and whether it is in a penalty, and with securities sufficient, and finds that the said bond is objectionable - the said bond is in the penalty of \$1000 and John R. Gray is the only surety.
