 Your commissioner reports to the Court, that about the day of July last Cassius P. Lee the guardian of Louis A. Casper, exhibited before your commission, a statement of all the money which he, the said Guardian had received or become chargeable with, or had disbursed, within the year ending on the 1st day of January 1869 together with the vouchers for such disbursements, and also that the said Guardian on the 10th day of December 1869 exhibited before your commissioner an account of all his receipts and disbursements for the current year ending on the 1st day of January 1870, together with the vouchers for such disbursements. That the commissioner embraced the said guardian in the list of fiduciaries whose account were before him for settlement, which was posted at the front door of the Court House of said County, on the first day of October last, and on the date of this report (ten days having elapsed since the said account was mentioned in the said list) made up and completed an account of the said Cassius P. Lee's guardianship for the two years ending as aforesaid, and on the 1st day of January 1870 finds a balance of \$247.00 due from Louis A. Casper the said ward, to Cassius P. Lee the said Guardian. The account is supported by satisfactory vouchers and is herewith returned. Your commissioner further reports to the Court, that he has examined whether the said guardian has given such bond as the law requires and whether it is in conformity and with securities sufficient, and finds the same to be satisfactory and fully sufficient.
