December the 22^d day 1778 I Andrew Moore in the County of Augusta being Sick and Weak in body but in perfect Mind and Memory thank be given to God the Lord calling to mind the Mortality of my body and that this appointed for all Men's to Dye do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament that is to say Principally and first of all I give and recommend my soul unto the hands of God that have it and for my body I do commend it to the Earth to be buried in a Christian like and decent Manner at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the Mighty power of God. And as for such worldly Estate where with hath pleased God to bless me with in this life I give and dispose of the same in the following Manner,

I give the Plantation between Alex^r Moore and Samuel Moore which contains five hundred Acres of Land to be divided equally betwixt them by two parts different Years only Samuel to have the Improvement with that proviso that he help Alex^r to clear 10 or 12 Acres of Land And when they part Alexander to have the third part of the Crop And I give James Moore a Cow and William Moore five shillings and John Moore five shillings.

and that this appointed for all Men sons to Dy do make and ordain this
my last Will and Testament that is to say principally and first of all
I give and recomend my soul unto the hands of God that have it
and for my body I recomend it to the earth to be buried in a Christian
like and decent Manner at the discretion of my Executors nothing
doubting but at the general Resurrection I shall receive the same again
by the Mighty power of God. And as for such worldly Estate where with
hath pleased God to bless me with in this life I give and dispose of the same
in the following Manner

I give the plantation between Alex. Moore and Samuel Moore which con-
tains five hundred acres of Land to be divided equally betwixt them by two in-
different Men only Samuel to have the Improvement with Leah proviso
that he help Alex to clear 10 or 12 Acres of Land And when they part
Alexander to have the third part of the crop And I give James Moore
a cow and William Moore five shillings and John Moore five shillings
and Quenten Moore five shillings and David Moore five shillings.
And all the rest of the Moveables and Appurtenances to be divided between
Alex Moore and Samuel Moore and their Mother by two honest

Indignorous Men And I do hereby utterly disavow and disannul
 and every other former Testament Will and Legacies and Executors by
 me in any wise before time named And ordering this to be my last
 and Testament and no other as Witness I have hereunto set my hand
 this day and Year above written. Andrew Moor (Seal)
