Thirdly I give and bequeath unto my beloved friend William Hop
my Rifle Gun and great Coat and Catches and bells

Fourthly I give and bequeath unto my beloved friend Samuel
Carral one of my Caves

Lastly I give and bequeath all the rest of my Estate and goods unto
my beloved friend Ephraim Love whom I appoint my Executor
to my respective Debts in witness

in the Year 1750.
