the rest of my family and my son John a young Person more for his share
that I give with the rest when my Debt are paid and my Youngest
Child shall have him share as well as the Rest my wife shall have

The plantation as Long has the Lure and any one of my
Children that will keep there mother and she & them can
agree shall & may have the Lands Now in Possession by
their father there is fifty Acres of Land I do give to my son
Jacob so this being my Last will & Testament In witness
whereof I have set my hand and seal this twenty third day of
August one thousand seven hundred & fifty my Executors are
Frederick Storrs and Humphry Baker
