Thanks to God for the same Calling to mind the Mortality of my body knowing
That it is Appointed for all men Once to Die I do make and ordain this
My Last Will and Testament That is to Say Principally and first of all
I give and Recommend My Soul into the hands of God that gave it And for my
Body I recommend it to the Earth to be buried in a Christian like and decent manner
at the Discretion of my Executors Nothing Doubting but at the General Resurrection
I shall receive the same Again by the mighty Power of God And as Touching
Such worldly Estate where in it pleased God to bless me with this Life I give
Divide and Dispose of the same in the following manner And first I give
And bequeath Unto my Sister Sarah Scot two mares that I had of Eden -
A Negro and a Cow & half I give to my Sister Phoe Scot one gray mare & a
cow & half I give to my Sister Pracht Scot one Roan mare & a cow I give
Unto my three Cousins James Scot Joseph Scot and Jacob Scot one black
mare to be Equally Divided between them I give unto my two Brothers -
Abijah Scot and David Scot My Plantations to be Equally Divided between
them And for the remainder part of my Estate I am unto my three Sons

them as for the remainder part of my Estate I give unto my three brothers
Benjamin Scot Adonijah Scot and Thos Scot to be Equally Divided amongst
them I request that if either of my two younger brothers should die before he is
of Age that the Estates which I give to him should be Equally Divided between
the other two, And I do hereby utterly disavow revoke and disannul all and
every other former Testaments Wills Legacies by me in any ways before this time
Named Wills bequeathed Ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my
Last will & Testament IN WITNESS WHEREOF I have hereunto set my hand
Seal the day and Year Above Written
