to her or not. Item I leave to my eldest daughter Elizabeth Bohanan
the small mare and colt and a pair of calves called by the name of gentle
and calf and the black gown that I wear Item I leave to my granddaugh-
ter Sean Bohanan a greenish gown and pocket and a wearing paper basket
may suit Item I leave to my second daughter Margaret Campbell the table
cloth I bought from Ireland Item I leave to my granddaughter the bay
coat that was lately put to Elizabeth Bohanan Item I give my grand-
daughter Mary Bohanan a bed tick and the dipper that is not made with
a pot and Vetch and the poor bay mare and colt Item I order the remainder
of what goods there is in the house and wheel and the floor and the rest of all
my movables that I have not time to mention nor am I to think on
order them all to my granddaughter Mary Bohanan in witness whereof I
have here unto set my hand and seal this 22nd day of 1753

have hereunto set my hand and seal this third day of August and in 24th year
of our said 1747
