that it is appointed for all Men Once to dye do make and or-
dain this my last Will and Testament that is to say prin-
cipally and first of all I give and recommend my soul unto the
hands of God who gave it. And for my body I recommend to the Law
to be buried in a Christian like Manner at the discretion of my
Executors nothing doubting at the General Resurrection I shall
receive the same again by the Mighty power of God, And as
touching the worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to
bless me in this Life I give devise and dispose of the same in the
following Manner and form
In witness whereof I have signed and do order that in the last place
all my just Debts and Funeral Charges be paid and Satisfied

Then I give and bequeath unto Hannalee my dearly beloved wife all my Lands
 and Tenements with all my goods and Moveables during her Natural Life
 and to bequeath as she shall think fitting whom I appoint executor of John Dobbin's
 Ex^r of this my last will and testament and yet he hereby doth allow revoke and dis-
 annull all and every other former Testaments and Wills Legacies and
 Ex^r by me in W^y in any ways before this time named willed or bequeathed
 ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last will and ratifying
 and confirming this and no other to be my last will and Testament in
 Witnes^s whereof I have herunto set my hand and seal the day and Year
 above written
