I order that my son John shall have forty pounds of that Money W^m Burden
is due to me the red Cow and a year old heifer and the half of the sheep
and the Roan Mare and Cows and the poll that W^m Burden is to bring with
the plow and tackle and all the things that is about the house belonging
to W^m Burden

I order that my Daughter Agnes shall have twenty pounds
of that Money that Mr. Borden is due to me with a red Cow and all

shall come to y^e hands or possession of the said Agnis or into the hands and possession
of any other person or persons for her do well and truly administer according
to Law. And further do make a just and true Account of his Receipts and disburse-
ments when thereunto required by y^e said Court and all the rest and residue of the
said Goods Chattells and Credits which shall be found remaining upon y^e said Adm^r
Accounts the same being first examined and allowed by the Justices of the said Court
for the time being shall deliver and pay unto such persons or persons respective-
