Item I bequeath my personal Estate to be equally divided in three parts  
And one of those three parts to be equally divided Among Eight Children  
the other two parts to be equally divided among my own six Children  
And my plantation I bequeath to my own two eldest sons John Shoup  
and Adam Shoup And I hereby make and appoint my loving friends  
George Carpenter and Jacob Pence full and Sole Executors of this my last  
Will and Testament hereby revoking Disannulling and making Void all  
former Wills and bequests by me made and declaring this only to be my  
last Will and testament In witness whereunto I have set my hand
