 the third part of my Estate or at her death her Motion and buy Ware
 and one Milch Cow one Live Lamb and to be maintained by the Estate
 together with her own Industry and the remainder to be returned to the
 Estate at her death
 I give and bequeath to my son John Lush one shilling
 I give and bequeath to my daughter Agnes wife to Matthews
 Young one Patron for a Cow
 I give and bequeath to my son James Lush all that remains of
 my Estate after the above bequeathments to him and his Assigns forever
 And do constitute and appoint the said James Lush my sole Ex^r over
 all that I do devise and make void all Wills Testaments

and do publish proclaim and declare this to be my last will and Testa-
ment in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this -
