This is the
 Day of December in the year of Our Lord 1752, I Peter Colner of Au-
 gusta County and Colony of Virginia German being sick and weak
 in body but of Perfect mind and memory thanks be given to God therefor And
 calling to mind the mortality of my body And knowing that it is appointed for
 All men Once to dye do make and declare this my Last Will and Testament
 that is to say principally And first of all I Give and recommend my Soul into
 the hands of God that gave it And for my body I recommend it to the Earth to be
 Buried in A Christian Like and Decent Manner at the Discretion of my
 Executors Nothing Doubting but At the General Resurrection I Shall receive
 the Same Again by the mighty Power of God And As Touching such
 Worldly Estate wherewith it hath Pleased God to bless me in this
 Life I Give devise And dispose of my following Manner And from
 Impres it is my will And So order that in the first place all my
 Just Debts and funeral Charges be paid and satisfied
 Item I Give and bequeath unto my Eldest Son George the one half of the
 this Land that I now possess to have his heirs or Assigns for ever
 The other half to my Son Peter to him his heirs for ever And it is my Will

My Land that I now live upon to have his heirs or assigns for ever of
The other half to my Son Peter to have his heirs for ever And it is my Will
and I do order that this Land be Equally Divided between them both
So as each of them may have Water and of either of them should
Dye without Children that his Part of Said Land shall return to next
Brother living and it is my Will and I do order that my Eldest son
George shall pay the Sum of twelve pounds Ten Shillings to his younger
Brother at the time that he shall be of the age of Twenty one and Twelve
Pound Ten Shillings In twelve months after Immens this is my Will
and I do order that my Second Son Peter shall pay the sum of Twelve
Pounds Ten Shilling to my Daughter Mary when she shall come to age of
Eighteen year and the sum of Twelve pounds Ten Shillings in Twelve months
after good and Lawfull money of Virginia Item I give and bequeath
Unto my well beloved wife the Third Part of all my Household Goods and furniture
and also the third part of my moveable Estate whatsoever to her here heirs or assigns
for ever and the other two thirds to be reserved for the bringing up of my
Children and what is Left of the two thirds to be divided equally amongst
my four Children In witness whereof it is my Will and I do order that my
witness my hand and seal this 10th day of June 1681

Iye without Children that two Part of said Land shall return to next
Brother living and it is my will And I do order that my eldest son
George shall pay the sum of twelve pounds ten shillings to his younger
brother at the time that he shall be of the age of Twenty one and twelve
pound ten shillings In twelve months after my decease And I do order

pound ten shilling to my Daughter Mary when she shall come to age of
Eighteen year and the sum of Twelve pound Ten Shillings in Twelve months
after good and Lawfull money of Virginia Item I give and bequeath
unto my well beloved wife the third Part of all my Household Goods and furniture
and also the third part of my moveable Estate whatsoever to her here living or after
my decease And the other two thirds to be reserved for the bringing up of my
Children and what is Left of these two thirds to be divided equally amongst
my four Children In witness whereof it is my Will and I do Order that my
well beloved wife Mary shall have free Privilege of my House
and Plantations during her widowhood And not to be disturbed by any
except when becometh that she waste or Disturb the Childrens Estate
Notifying that I have confirmed this and more other to be my Last
