I do make this my last will and Testament

That is to say principally and first of all I give and recommend my soul
unto God that gave it and for my body I recommend it to the Earth to be
buried in a Christian like Manner at the discretion of my Executors nothing
Doubting but at general Resurrection I shall receive the same again by
the Almighty power of God and touching such worldly Estate that it hath
pleased God to bestow on me with in this life I give and dispose of as follows in Writing
and some following Imprimis I will all My funeral Charges to be paid and
all my just Debts to be paid & satisfied & twenty Shillings to my Writing house

Item I give and bequeath to my son John King my four horses &
Apigres forever my old plantation of three hundred & fifty Acres and one
black horse & one stallion Colt & two cows

Item I give to Catherine my beloved wife my plantation
on of falling Spring and the Well with all the benefits thereof during her
Widowhood and if she Marry she shall have but her third and the rest
to be equally divided among my three daughters Sarah, Elizabeth &
Katherine King and also will and bequeath to my wife all the remain
of my estate to be sold and the proceeds to be paid to my three

my Moveables during her life and at her decease to fall to my three
daughters or some of them as shall be then alive 17 for ^{John} Robert
Poage and John Anderson to be Ex^r to this my last Will & Testament
& to execute Doods for y^e said Willed by me This will I publish to
be my last Will & Testament, all other Wills made by me to be void
