

In the name of god amen I Robert Jagers late from
the province of Pennsylvania being at this present time in a sick
and low condition but of sound Judgment and perfect memory
and calling to mind the frailty of man and the uncertainty
of life I therefore first of all recommend my spirit to god who
gave it, and my goods to be disposed off in the following manner
(viz) first that all my debts due by me and my funeral charges
be paid out of the to late of my Estate after it hath been truly appraised
and valued in ready money by proper persons thereunto appointed
upon both secondly I order and allow that twenty pounds of
money be equally divided between my two sons William and Alexander
to which sum I order to be by them laid out upon land for their
respective use; thirdly I order that the remainder of my Estate
be divided equally in three parts and that the one half thereof
so divided be given to my two sons William and Alexander to be
equally enjoyed by them fourthly I order that the other half

reputative use; thirdly order that the remainder of my estate
be divided equally in three parts and that the one half thereof

of my estate being divided as above be equally divided into four
parts the first of which I have and bequeath unto my well
beloved wife Catherine Sayer and unto each of my three
Daughters Margaret, Anne, and Elizabeth Grace one of the
remaining three parts mentioned above and as my last will
and testament only in good and better if thereof after my
Decease there is any surplus remaining that my family in

7. Shall Judge Proper to sell I allow my sons to sell the same after shall
been attained and they shall only be accountable to the gift of the
legates for the value sets thereon by the appraisers also it is my
will and Desire that my wife and Daughters be supported and
maintained by my two sons During my wife's widowhood or my
Daughters minority and in case my wife should marry I allow and
Order that there shall be given to her one third of what my Estate a-
mounts to the above sum of twenty pounds and the debt of Subtra-
cted therefrom by the Appraisement and that the remainder be divid-
ed in minor and form mentioned above and should any difference
or Disputes arise in my family after my Decease concerning my
Estate I desire that one or more honest men be Indifferently chosen
to Decide the same to whose Judgment and determination they
shall submit and farther that each one in my family be obliged
to give acct. of what they were possessed of Belonging to my Estate
at my Decease of thereto required by any one of them also thereby
compute order and appoint you John Buchanan

wrong either my wife or Daughters out of their

he is dying signed to take the same in their consideration and

Appoint proper persons for that purpose who shall view &

 my Daughters by my will and to be accountable to them
 for the same when it shall be taken or called for by them
 and so forth.
