I give devise & dispose of in the following Manner
In primis it is my Will and I do order that all my Just Debts and General
Charges be paid and Satisfied
Item I give to my well beloved son Frederick Broch one two year old Ward
Colt, a faw and an Equal Share of my Goods and Moveables.
Item I give to my ^{well beloved} daughter Christiana Tunkhouser an equal
Share of my goods and moveables
Item I give to my well beloved Daughter Julian Broch a three year old
four years old a faw and a pair of two year old and two year old and two year old
of my goods and Moveables

from I give to my
Share of my goods and moveables

Item I give to my well beloved Daughter Julian Broth a Servile Ward
four years old a cow and a steer two year old and two of an Equal share
of my goods and moveables

Item I give to my well beloved son George Broth a two year old black Ward
one heifer three year old & one cow & two hundred and fifty acres of Land
including the plantation I now live on to his heirs & assigns forever and
he is to pay as much out of the said Land together children yearly as makes
them all equal shares

Item I give to my well beloved Daughter Eve Broth one two year old Ward
black colour, a black heifer and one cow and an Equal share of my Goods
& moveables.

I do constitute and appoint John Dobehm & to Mr James my only & sole
Ex^{rs} of this my Last Will and Testament, and I do utterly disallow and
Revoke all other Wills and Testaments heretofore Willed by me in
any wise named Willed and bequeathed ratifying and confirming this
to be my last Will and Testament
