and being desirous to dispose of all such worldly Estate as it hath pleased God to bless
with I give and Bequeath the same in the manner following that is to say I give
and Bequeath unto my Loving Wife my house with all the moveable property therein
and the garden belonging to the house likewise she is to have thirty Bushels of wheat
and thirty Bushels of Corn delivered unto her yearly of my Land by my two sons John
Runkle and Jeremiah Runkle each of them to give alike and to have half an acre
of Land for to have in place yearly and my sons aforementioned is to keep the said
house in good repair Likewise she is to have my black mare and two cows which
Jeremiah Runkle is to feed for her I give unto my Daughter Susanna my high fliter
with a bridle
mare and saddle and two cows which Jeremiah Runkle is keep for her while she remains
single Likewise I give unto my Daughter Susanna one hundred and fifty pounds Virginia
currency to be paid to her with in three years after my decease I give and Bequeath unto
my Daughter Polly Coffey one hundred and fifty acres of my Land (the place where George
Coffey now lives) to remain unto her and her heirs forever

luffs now lives out to Begun at a Spanish oak corner to Down at Hanes Lane thence
to go with all mares lanes till a line from Bells Lane will make the quantity required
which I give to her and her heirs forever I give and Bequeath unto my daughter Peggy
Smith one milk cow: I give and Bequeath unto my son James two Dollars I give
and Bequeath unto my son John two hundred and fifty acres of my Land where he
now lives to begin on the South side of Jennings Branch along the Dam he has
for watering his mares thence to come into the channel of the Branch below
the Dam and down with the course of the Branch to the foot of the steel branch
meadow thence crossing the bottom below the said meadow place to George Luffs
line then from the corner at the said Dam to cross the Branch above the dam with
a straight line to the outside line of my Land for the quantity required
which I give unto him and his heirs forever I give and Bequeath unto my son
Jeremiah two hundred and eighty acres of my Land the part where I now live which
I give unto him and his heirs forever likewise I give unto my son Jeremiah all
the mares Bonds and accounts due to me with all other of my movable property that
is not mentioned in this will provided that there should be any money left
after the paying my debts and the Legacies herein left out of the movable property
I allow it to be divided equally among my three daughters namely Peggy Dolly
and Susanna which is to be given unto them at the decease of my Beloved
wife and lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my son Jeremiah Runkle
and my friend Daniel Fall Executors of this my last Will and testament
in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this

which I give unto him and his heirs forever I give and Bequeath unto my son
Jeremiah two hundred and eighty acres of my land the part where I now live which
I give unto him and his heirs forever Likewise I give unto my son Jeremiah all

At about 12 o'clock for Augusta County, October the 25th 1802

This last will and Testament of Samuel Rankle deceased was proved by the Oaths of Philip and John Roberts two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded, and on the motion of Jeremiah Rankle and Daniel Fall the Executors thereof named who made oath according to law together with Philip Rankle and John Roberts their Securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of \$2000 conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted them for obtaining approval thereof in due form.

In the name of God AMEN the second day of February 1802 I John Henley of the County of Augusta being in perfect mind and memory thanks to given unto god therefore calling unto mind the mortality of my body and that it is appointed for all men once to die do make and ordain this my last will and Testament as follows
