the Mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for All Men
ones today do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament that is to
say principally and first of all I give and recom and my soul into the hand
of God that have it and for my body I recommend it to the Earth to be buried
in a Christian like and decent Manner at the discretion of my Executors nothing
doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by
the Mighty power of God And as touching such worldly Estate wherewith it
hath pleased God to bless me in this life I give devise and dispose of the
Same in the following Manner and force

Imprimis it is my Will and I do order that in the first place all my
Just Debts and funeral Charges be paid and satisfied

I then give and bequeath unto my well beloved wife Sarah the third of all
my personal Estate and the benefit of my Land and improvements until
my Eldest Son Thomas James comes to age to bring up my Children
and if Sarah my beloved wife should marry before my Eldest Son
Thomas comes of Age that then the two thirds of my personal Estate
to be equally divided among all my Children both boys and girls
if my Executors fees be paid

I now my Will is that my three sons Thomas Joshua and Joseph
shall have my tract of Land which is three hundred and fifty one acres
to be equally divided between the three both for quantity and quality
