I will to be equally divided Between my Daugh-
ters Sarah Wallace, Elizabeth Wooddell, Martha
Hansel and Jane Erwin. to be to ^{their} use and their
Assigns forever, Noty revoking all other wills
made by me & acknowledging this Only to
be my Last Will and Testament in Witness
Whereof I have hereunto subscribed my
Name and affixed my seal this 15th day of
January in the year of our Lord one thou-
sand eight hundred and Ten. and do appoint
John Lewis the Executor of this my Last Will
