this my last will & testament in the fol-

Thomas Wooddell one Dollar and to my son
John Wooddell one Dollar and all the remain-
ing part of my estate Both Real and personal
I will to be equally divided Between my Daugh-
ters Sarah Wallace, Elizabeth Wooddell, Martha
Hansel and Jane Cowen to be their
Aigne forever, hereby revoking all other wills
made by me & acknowledging this Only to
be my last Will and Testament in Writing
whereof I have hereunto Subscribed my
Name and affixed my seal this 15th day of
January in the year of our Lord one thou-
sand eight hundred and ten and do appoint
John being the Executor of this my last Will
