Confirm all the Ratings and doings of these my attorneys which
may in any wise concern me or any business in which I have
interest hereunto before my hand, and seal this fifth day of May
in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and thirty
four

Samuel Vance to the above said Robert McGuffin his heirs &c
in the sum of one thousand Dollars yearly by these presents
