of Bath County and State of Virginia being aged
and unimpaired of sound judgment and mem-
ory calling to mind the Mortality of all Men
do make and ordain this my last Will and Tes-
tament Revoking all former Wills and Testaments
respecting my worldly substance and constituting
this my last Will in manner following viz:

I Bequeath my soul to god who gave it in hope of
a happy and glorious immortality through the me-
diation of the Saviour Christ and my body
to the earth from whence it was taken in hope
of a resurrection to a spiritual and glorious existence
this body to be buried in a decent like manner
Item I desire that all my just debts and funeral
expenses be discharged -- and as to my world-
ly goods I bequeath in the manner following. I bequeath
to John Wilson fifty Dollars to be paid by my executors. I
bequeath to my sister Margaret Green
deceast daughter Jane Stevenson fifty dollars
out of my estate to be paid by my executors. I
bequeath to my sister Barbara Wilson all my land
that I now possess and to dispose of it at her
