The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above bound James A. Hamilton has been appointed a constable in this County agreeable to an act of assembly concerning Constables. Now if the said James A. Hamilton shall well and truly discharge the duties of his said office of constable agreeable to the said act of assembly then the above obligation to be void else to remain in full force.
