In the name of God amen I Elizabeth Wilson
 of Bath County and State of Virginia being aged
 and uniform but of sound judgment and mem-
 ory calling to mind the Mortality of all Men
 do make and ordain this my last will and Tes-
 tament Revoking all former wills and Testaments
 respecting my worldly substance and constitute
 this my last will in manner following Viz:
 I Bequeath my soul to god who gave it in hopes of
 a happy and glorious immortality through the me-
 diation of the Lord Jesus Christ and my body
 to the earth from whence it was taken in hopes
 of a resurrection to a spiritual and glorious existence
 this body to be buried in a decent like manner
 Item I believe that all my just debts and funeral
 expenses be discharged -- and as to my world-
 ly goods I bequeath in the manner following I bequith
 to John Wilson fifty Dollars to be paid by my Execu-
 tors I bequith to my sister Margaret Green
 deest daughter Jane Stephenson fifty dollars
 out of my estate to be paid by my Executors I
 bequith to my sister Barbara Wilson all my land
 that I now possess and to dispose of it at her

dissolve as she pleas likewise the land that is
coming to me from my sister Susanna Wilsons
Estate Likewise all that is coming Money and
Bonds to her her heirs and assigns forever -
likewise all the part of the Negroes that is coming

part of the stock Cattle and hogs and sheep
and hogs and all farming Utensils and all
my part that is in the House ^{and} with all the
furniture therein and all the Kitchen furniture
therein I bequith to Mr. Greene one hundred
dollars and his choice of a pair out of
my horse stock to him and his heirs for ever - I
nominate and appoint William Greene and my
sister Barbara Wilson Execs this my last will and
Testament Revoking all former wills ~~made~~
and allowing this to be my last will and Testament
made and done this fifteenth day of April one thousand

and pay the same to the Officers to whom such fees are due
as actually at such times as are prescribed and limited by
Law and well and truly execute and due return make
of all process and precepts to him directed and pay
and satisfy all sums of money and tobacco by him re-
ceived by virtue of such process to the person or persons
to whom the same is due his or their Executors admini-
strators or assigns and in all things shall truly and faith-
fully execute and perform the said office of Sheriff
during the time of his continuance therein then the above
obligation to be void otherwise to remain in full force and virtue
