ourselves our heirs Executors and administrators jointly and
severally firmly by these presents sealed with our seals
and dated this 10th day of September. 1822

The Condition of the above obligation is such that when as the above bound John Brown is constituted and appointed Sheriff of Bath County by Commission from the Governor under the Seal of the Commonwealth dated the 17th day of August 1809. Therefore the said John Brown shall well and truly collect and receive all officers fees and due put into his hands to collect and duly account for and pay the same to the officers to whom such fees are due respectively at such times as are prescribed and limited by Law and well and truly Execute and due returns make of all moneys and receipts to him directed and pay and satisfy all sums of money and tobacco by him received by virtue of such process to the person or persons to whom the same is due his or their Executors administrators or assigns and in all things shall truly and faithfully execute and perform the said Office of Sheriff during the time of his continuance therein then the above obligation to be void otherwise to remain in full force and virtue
