Henry Rockey is seized in fee of of all that messuage
or tenement and certain pieces or parcels of land situate
in Augusta County in the state of Virginia Now the pro-
perty Henry Rockey now knowe that the said Henry
Rockey with by these presents constitute Authorize and

Impower Frederick Rockey in the Township of Rest County
of Lancaster and state of Pennsylvania to sell grant or
convey the same in fee simple for such price or sum of
Money, and such person or persons as he shall think
convenient, and also for him the S^t Henry Rockey and
in his name to seal execute and deliver such deeds and
conveyances bargains and sales for the absolute seal and
disposal therefore or of any part thereof with such clauses
covenants and agreements there unto contained as he the
S^t Frederick Rockey shall think fit and expedient hereby
ratifying and confirming all such Deeds bargain sales
and other conveyances which shall at any time hereaf-
ter be made sealed executed and delivered by him the
said Frederick Rockey touching or concerning the pre-

of Bath and state of Virginia &c
being in a very feeble state of health but of perfect mind and
memory thanks be to god for his mercies, and calling to mind
the mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed
once for all men to die I do make ordain and appoint this
to be my last will and testament the first of all I do Rec-
ommend my soul to almighty god that gave it and my body
to the earth from whence it came to be buried in a Christian
and decent manner at the discretion of my Executors Nothing
doubting but that I shall receive it again at the last day by
the mighty power of god Next I do appoint my Trusty ser-
vants James Hobson to be my whole and sole Executor and as

for such worldly Estate wherein with its birth pleased god to bless
me with in this life I do will and dispose of in the manner
hereinafter following that is after all my just debts and
funeral charges being paid and fully satisfied &c.
Item I will and bequeath to my only surviving son Robert
Setlington my Negro fellow Lish to his own use and disposi-
tion for ever as he may see fit my best coat and jacket
trousers & big byble. Next I will and bequeath to my daughterr
Jane Crawford twenty pounds cash to her own disposi-
tion &c. Item I will and bequeath to my daughter Jessie Blane
twenty pounds in cash for and to her own use & disposal &c.
Next I will and bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Helms my
home plantation with all its building orchards and improve-
ments of every kind thenceunto belonging to be at her disposi-
tion or proper use to herself and heirs forever as she in her choice
or wisdom may see fit and further I will my daughter Elizabeth
twenty pounds in cash and my Negro slave Nell to her
own and at her disposal as she may think proper &c. Next I
do will and bequeath unto my daughter Mary Young twenty
pounds cash to be for her own proper use &c. Next and last
I do will and bequeath unto my daughter Ann Ratty twenty
pounds cash for her own proper use & benefit &c and should
there be a balance of the movable property still behind after
paying off the whol legatee as above mentioned be it were as
exp I will and bequeath it to be equally divided among the
whol of my daughters whose Names are above written &c and
I do renounce reject and disallow all and every other Will
or wills heretofore by me made ratifying and confirming this
to be my last will and testament as witness my hand and
seal this twelfth day of September one thousand seven hundred
and ninety two 1792
