This Statement of account of Charles Hammon one of the Administrators of Thomas Gatewood dec^d together with a receipt executed by Andrew de Gatewoods the only heir was presented in court and ordered to be Recorded.

In the name of God Amen I William de Dean of the County of Bath and state of Virginia do make and constitute this my last will and Testament and dispose of my property as follows to wit, It is my Will and desire that all my last debts be fully paid as soon as possible after my decease and for that purpose my Executors hereafter named shall make sale of my Negro Men Aba and Shadrach together with as much other property as can be most conveniently spared as will be sufficient for that purpose. I Will and bequeath unto my five sons to wit John, James, Samuel, Charles, and William - the tracts of Land on Gallison Mountains called and known by the name of the humberling place to them and their heirs forever to be divided equally or sold as they choose. I Will and bequeath unto my son James a young mare now claimed by him, I Will and bequeath unto my son Samuel a young mare now claimed by him. The residue of my property of every description, after the payment of my debts and funeral expenses. I Will and bequeath unto my wife Sarah for and during her Natural life to assist her in raising and educating my younger children and at her death it is my Will that the said property with all the increase of the female slaves be equally divided amongst my daughters, to wit Rebecca, Emily Jane, and Sarah and to their heirs forever. I do hereby constitute and appoint my wife Sarah Executors and John Bolton and William de Clinton executors of this my last will and Testament.

In Testimony whereof I have hereunto subscribed my name and affixed my seal this 13th day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty seven
