 our seals and dated this 10th day of June one thousand seven hundred
 and thirty one and in the 16th year of the Commonwealth.

The Condition of this Obligation is that if the said John Hammett
 Executor of the last will and Testament of the said Goods Chattels and
 Credits of Joseph Lantry deceased do make a true and perfect
 Inventory of all and singular the Goods Chattels and Credits of the said
 Dec'd which have or shall come to the hands or possession or knowledge
 of him the said John Hammett or into the hands or possession of
 any other person or persons for him and the same to make as he
 shall think fit into the County Court at such time as he shall be thereunto required
 by the said Court and the same Goods Chattels and Credits do well
 & truly administer according to law and make a just and true
 Account of his doings and usings therein when sheweth required
 by the said Court and further do well and truly pay and re-
 turn all the Legacies contained and specified in the said
 will as far as the said Goods Chattels and Credits will extend
 according to the Value thereof and as the Law shall Charge
 thereon then this Obligation to be void or else to remain in full
 force
