Likewise to my daughter Sally Davidson, ten dollars, likewise to my daughter Mary Ann May ten Dollars, likewise to my daughter Eliza Davidson ten Dollars, and likewise to my daughter Hannah May ten Dollars. I have also bequeath to my wife all the ready money that is

in my possession at the time of my decease. I will and bequeath to my son John May and my friends him and his heirs forever. I do constitute and appoint Joseph Woodliffe Lewis and William Womack to be executors of this my last will and Testament.
