bound John Brown is constituted and appointed Sheriff of Bath County
by Commission from Thomas M Randolph Governor of the Common-
wealth of Virginia dated the 20th day of July in the year 1821
if, therefore the said John Brown shall truly and faithfully collect
account for and pay the Taxes imposed by Law within the said County
of Bath for the year 1821 and all arrears of Taxes due within the
County as also all militia fines imposed by Law within said County
and all arrears of militia fines due in his County as the Law directs
then this Obligation to be void otherwise to remain in full force and
virtue
