WHEREAS by these presents that we John Brown Jacob Warick John Dean & James Graham are heirs and executors bound unto James Wood Esquire Governor of Virginia and his successors for the time being in the sum of One thousand Dollars which payment well and truly to be made we bind ourselves our heirs executors and administrators jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and Dated this 10th day of May 1799 -

The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above bound John Brown is constituted and appointed Sheriff of the county of Bath commissary from the Governor under the seal of the Commonwealth dated the 10th day of April last past is therefore the said John Brown shall well and truly collect and receive all officers fees and dues paid into his hands to collect and duly account for and pay the same to the officers to whom such fees are due respectively at such times as are prescribed and limited by law and shall well and truly execute and due return make of all process and precept to him directed and pay and satisfy all sums of money and tobacco by him received by virtue of any such process to the person or persons to whom the same are due, his or their executors administrators or assigns and in all other things shall truly and faithfully execute and perform the said office of Sheriff during the time of his continuance therin, then the above obligation to be void also terminate in full force -
