shall Receive the same as the General Provision I shall Occur
the same again and as for my worldly Estate I give Nomine and
Bequeath the same in the following Manner and from first I
Bequeath to my Son William his Children and to my Son John his
Children and to my Son James I Give and Bequeath my Bowls
My Horse and Saddle and all Other My Estate Except I Give
and Bequeath to my Daughter Anne Constantha Beck also I give
and Bequeath to my Daughter Mary and my other daughter Beck
also I give and Bequeath to my Daughter Lydia Willy one
Dollar Tales make and except in my Son James My sole Executer
of this My Last will and Testament and I do hereby Revancell
all Other Wills or Testaments and appoint this to be My Last
will and Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my
Hand and seal this tenth Day of April 1794

bound John Dean is appointed Sheriff of Bath County by Comptroller from
Henry Lee Esq^r Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia During Date
the 26th day of July in the year 1794 and Thirtieth of the Commonwealth
of Virginia the said John Dean shall True and faithfully collect
and account for and pay the amount of the Public Taxes Imposed
by Law within the said County of Bath for the year 1793 as the law
Directs Then the above Obligation to be void Else to remain in force
