Manner at the Discretion of my Executors Nothing Doubting But I
shall Receive the same at the General Resurrection I shall Receive
the same again and as for my worldly Estate I Give Bequeath and
Bequeith the same in the following Manner and form first I
Bequeith to My son William Six Shillings and to My son John Six
Shillings and to My son James I Give and Bequeith My Cloaths
My Horse and Saddle and all Other My Estate except I Give
and Bequeith to My Daughter Anne and father Beir also I Give
and Bequeith to My Daughter Margaret and My other father Beir
also I Give and Bequeith to My Daughter Liddy Willey one
Dollar Sales Make and receive in My son James My Sole Executor
of this My Last Will and Testament and I do hereby Bequeath
all Other Wills or Testaments and appoint this to be My Last
Will and Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and seal this Tenth Day of April 1774

the 26th day of July in the Year 1774 and Sheriff of the Commonwealth
if therefore the said John Dean shall True and faithfully collect
and account for and pay the amount of the Public Taxes Impose
pay Laws within the said County of Bath for the year 1773 as the Law
Directs then the above Obligation to be void else to remain in force
