Bath County this Setting in the sum of five hundred pounds to the pay-
ment whereof will and may be made to the said Justices and their Successors
in trust or under and each of us our and each of our Heirs Executors
and Administrators jointly and severally jointly by these presents sealed with
our seals and dated this 12th day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred
and Ninety one and in the 16th year of the Commonwealth.

The Condition of this Obligation is that if the said John Hamilton
Executor of the last will and testament of all the Goods Chattels and
Credits of Ralph Savery because he make a sum or a perfect
Inventory of all and singular the Goods Chattels and Credits of the said
Dec'd which have or shall come to the hands of hisfif or Knowledge
of him the said John Hamilton or into the hands of hisfif or Knowledge of
any other Person or Persons for him and the same to make and enter
into the county Court at such time as he shall be required by
the said Court and the same Goods Chattels and Credits so well
as fully administer according to law and make a just and true
Account of his Actions and doings therein when he comes Required
by the said Court and further so well and fully pay and give
him all the Legacies contained and specified in the said
will as far as the said Goods Chattels and Credits will extend
according to the Value thereof and as the Law shall Charge
him from this Obligation to be paid or else to remain in full
paid.

a certain tract of Land situate on the waters of Greenbrier
River in said County of Bath and known by the name of the
Rich Lands which lands has been obtained in the Court of
Commissioners and which the said William Sharp unjustly
keeps in his possession duly certifying and confirming
and by these presents allowing, whatsoever my said attor-
ney shall lawfully do in the premises in witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and seal the 30th day
