 ment whereby will and duty to be made to the said Justices and their Assignees
 we bind ourselves and each of us and our heirs Executors
 and Assigns jointly and severally jointly by these presents sealed with
 our seals and dated this 15th day of June one thousand seven hundred
 and thirty one and in the 16th year of the Commonwealth.

The Condition of this Obligation is that if the said John Hammett
 Executor of the last will and Testament of the said Goods Chatter and
 Credits of Joseph Savely Deceased do make a true and perfect
 Inventory of all and singular the Goods Chatter and Credits of the said
 Decd which have or shall come to the hands or possession or knowledge
 of him the said John Hammett or into the hands or possession of
 any other person or persons for him and the same to make as he
 hath into the County Court at such time as he shall be thereunto required
 by the said Court and the same Goods Chatter and Credits do well
 & truly administer according to law and make a just and true
 Account of his doings and doings therein when Sheweth Required
 by the said Court and further do well and truly pay and re-
 turn all the Legacies contained and specified in the said
 will as far as the said Goods Chatter and Credits will extend
 according to the Value thereof and as the Law shall Charge
 him then this Obligation to be void or else to remain in full
 force.

 River in said County of Bath and known by the Name of the
 Rich Land which Land has been obtained in the Court of
 Commissioners and which the said William Sharp unjustly
 detains in his possession. Truly Satisfying and Confirming
 and by these presents allowing, whatsoever my said At-
 torney shall lawfully do in the premises in witness whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand and seal the 30th day
 of June in the year 1792 - James Bracken JS
