the said bargained premises unto the said John Banks Lewis his heirs
and assigns forever and I the said Margaret Lewis for myself my
heirs executors and administrators shall and will warrant and forever
defend the said bargained property left. One negro man slave named
Patrick one Red cow with a white face and her calf three white cows
and three calves one bay horse called Bob one brown horse called
snath Antony unto the said John Banks Lewis and his heirs and
assigns forever against the claim of me or my heirs executors or
administrators or of any other person or persons whatsoever. In
