James John Dallas John Dean John Oliver & James Robinson Gentlemen Justices of the Court of Bath County Now sitting in the sum of one thousand pounds to the payment whereof we and duly to be made to the said Justices and their Successors we bind ourselves and each of us our and each of our heirs Executors and ad^{rs} jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and dated this 16th day of Feb^r 1792 one thousand seven hundred and Ninety two and in the 17th year of the commonwealth

The Condition of this obligation is that if the said John Nathaniel Clark Executor of the last will and Testament with the will annexed of all the Goods and Credits of James Clark Dec^d do make a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular the Goods Chattels and Credits of the said Dec^d which have or shall come to the hands possession or knowledge of him the said John Nathaniel Clark or into the hands or possession of any other Person or Persons for them and the same to make so Exhibited into the County Court at such time as they shall be thereto Required by the said Court and the same Goods Chattels and Credits do well and truly administer according to Law and make a just and true account of their dealings and receipts thereon when thereto Required by the said Court and further do well and truly pay and deliver all the Legacies contained and specified in the said will so far as the said Goods Chattels and Credits will extend according to the Value thereof and as the Law shall Charge them then this Obligation to be void and Else to remain in full force

In the Name of God Amen Ralph Savory of the County of Augusta and Commonwealth of Virginia concerning the uncertainty of this Mortal Life and living of Samuel Davis and Mary as the public Thanks to almighty God for the same do make and publish this my last will and Testament in Manner and form following (Imprimis) I will and Order all my just Debts to be paid. Item I give and Bequeath to my Beloved wife Jane one third of all my personal Estate one young Bay Horse and Saddle a small Steer on his forehead and a Heifer of three years old of a Spotted Cream Color and two Sheep wearing his widow hood but at her Marriage or Death I will and Order said Goods and Chattels to be given to the second eldest Son of John Hamelton of the County of Rockbridge and State of Virginia which is my Grand son of the Name of Ralph now a bout six months old I likewise give and Bequeath to my Daughter Rebecca Hamelton six Sheep of the Value thereof the Remainder of my personal Estate I will and Order to be Equally divided betwixt my three daughters Agnes Hadden Sarah Clark (to said Sarah Clark one large Biber Glasses) and Martha Mack to my son William Savory I leave the sum of five Shillings Virginia Currency to be paid Out of my wife Jane's part which said sum I Legacies I will and Order to be paid to the said Executives Legates within six months after my decease I further give and devise to my said Daughter Rebecca Hamelton all my Real Estate Consisting of a certain tract of Land Consisting of a bout three hundred Aors situate on the Cuspashore River at the Mouth of Stricks Creek together with forty five Aors there unto annexed by Virtue of a Patent to hold to her the said Rebecca Hamelton during her Natural Life and at her Decease to Devise to her second Eldest son above mentioned of the Name of Ralph Hamelton and his heirs forever — And lastly I appoint My Son in Law the above mentioned John Hamelton and my Beloved wife Jane the sole Executors of this my last will and Testament Treating And Disannulling all former wills by me made in what manner soever I have hitherto put my hand and seal the seventeenth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Ninety two at the South Side was intended before signed

My wife Jane a published and confirmed by the above named Ralph Savory to be his last will and Testament in presence of four who have hereunto Subscribed our Names in presence of the said Ralph Savory
