This Indenture made the ninth day of July one thousand seven hundred and one thirty three Between John M. Roberts of Bath County and State of Virginia of the one part and Geo M. Roberts of the said County and State aforesaid of the other part witnesseth That the said John M. Roberts hath Given and Granted unto the said Geo M. Roberts a Certain Tract or Parcel of Land Containing one Hundred Acres Being in the State of Kentucky in Lincoln County on Newkinner Branch a part of Dick's River being part of a tract said John M. Roberts purchased of Charles Cameron joining John Bailey on the one side and Joseph Jackson on the other. Said Land to be Lay^d off in one or more surveys as the said Geo M. Roberts sees Cause joining the lines of the old Survey touching the Big Spring in the old Survey. For the Conveyance of said Land the said John M. Roberts doth appoint John Short of Lincoln County and State of Kentucky my lawful attorney to make a Just and Lawfull Deed and Title to said Geo M. Roberts his Heirs and assigns for ever in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this day and date above
