said State, to me, in hand, paid, by Andrew & Samuel Moore
and John Cawson, the Receipt whereof has been duly acknowledged
have bargained, sold and delivered, and by these presents
do bargain, sell and deliver unto the said Andrew & Samuel
Moore & John Cawson, Secretary, Deputy to W^{ill}
Our Negro Man, named, Patrick one Bay Horse supposed
to be ten years old and brown by the name of B.B. one Bay
Mare, about fifteen years old, with a Sway Back, brown
by the name of Sway-Back-Lolly, one Iron Gray-Mare seven
years old and young Colt, and young filly two years old, six
white Cows, of four years old, one Red Cow five years old,
one Red Cow three years old, two Black Hicifiers, three years
old, one Large Shetland white & Black Cow seven or eight years
old, three of one year old, three young Calves, one Child of Trainers
one Black, French, two belonging to the Walnut, two small Red
Walnut, one large Walnut ^{do}, three large Chairs, Walnut, Twelve Wal-
nut Bed Steads, one fine Writing Desk, one Bed, Twelve leather
Beds and Furniture, - Twelve Matresses, & Trunkets, - five large
Pots, - one large kettle, one large Braze Kettle then Dutch
Covers one Skillet, - two Axes, - one plough & back line, - two dozen
Dinner Ware Plates, - four Bowls do, three dozen pewter spoons

and the said Margaret Lewis for myself, my Heirs Executors Admin-
istrators and assigns shall and will warrant and forever defend
against all persons, by these presents the said Bargained premises
unto the said Andrew & Samuel Moore and John Cawson their
Heirs Executors Administrators and assigns, - provided nevertheless
that, if the said Margaret Lewis her Heirs or assigns shall will
and truly pay unto the above Andrew & Samuel Moore and
John Cawson their Heirs or assigns the above sum of three
hundred pounds on or before the first day of May next
then this Bargain and Sale shall be void any thing
herein contained to the contrary notwithstanding or
witness whereof the said Margaret hath delivered
unto the said Andrew ^{Moore}, the above named Negro Man named
Patrick in part and in the Name of all the Articles Com-
prised in this Bill of Sale, - and hath hereunto set
her hand and seal this 14th day of May 1793
