Years Old and Young Calf, and Young Filly Two Years Old, six
white Cows, of four Years Old, one Doe Cow five Year Old;
One Old Cow three Years Old, two Black Heifers, three Years
Old; One Large Shaded White & Black Cow Seven or eight Years
Old; One of one Year Old, three Young Calves, one Child of Drawers
