The Condition of the above Obligation is such that whereas the above bound Elisha B Williams is appointed by Bath County Court Guardian of Elizabeth Williams an Orphan Child The S Williams and if the said Elisha B Williams shall receive the ^{the} Estate of said Child and indemnify the Court there the above Obligation to be void else to remain in full force

In the Name of God Amen, I Matthias Benson last of my Branch Bath County & State of Virginia being in firm of body but sound of mind and calling to mind the certainty of Death and being desirous to dispose of my worldly Goods first I would recommend my Sole to God and my Body to the Earth to be buried in Christam Order by Executors it is my will that all my Just Debt & Funeral expenses be paid first then the rest of my Estate I give and bequeath as follows — I will and bequeath to my Son Matthias Benson all the Land whereon he now lives in Pendleton County Virginia to him his heirs & assigns forever also I give him one Negro Man named Harry to serve during Life to him his heirs or assigns — I will and bequeath to my two Sons Alexander Benson & William Benson all the Land whereon myself and they now live to be divided as it now stands making before Witness also I give to Alexander my Son one Negro Boy named George to him his heirs or assigns during his Life also I give to my Son William Benson one Negro Man named Samuel to him his heirs and assigns during Life also I give to my two Sons Alexander and William one Plantation on Antons Creek Greenbrier County to be divided in Equall Shares also one Tract of Land on Jacksons River Bath County known by the Rally Land to be divided equal between them also it is my Will that my Negroes patione & Negro Rachel shall have their Liberty to go to any of Children or grand Children that they choose to live with the remainder of their Land Days if they shall be living after my Death, Negro Judy and her family of Children shall be sold if they shall be in being or not sold before my Death also I give to my Grand Daughter Margaret Benson Daughter of Alexander Benson my son one Negro Child named Nancy a female to him his heirs or assigns during life, I will and bequeath to my Grand Son Matthias Benson Son of William Benson my Son one Negro Boy named Alfred

to have his heirs or assigns during his natural life
 also I will and bequeath to my Grandson Matthias Lock-
 wood Son of Lanty Lockwood and Elizabeth Lockwood
 my Daughter and Negro Boy named Jacob to him his
 heirs or assigns during life, also I will and bequeath
 to my grand Daughter Margaret Benson Daughter of Eliza-
 beth Benson my Son and Negro Girl named Sarah
 to her her heirs or assigns during life I will and bequeath
 to Sarah Wiley my Daughter one hundred pounds in
 Bonds or Cash, also I will to Elizabeth Lockwood one
 hundred pounds in Cash or Bonds for it, also I will and
 bequeath to Melly Wright 100 pounds in Cash or in
 Bonds for it I will to George Benson my Son sixty pounds
 in Cash or in Bonds for it, I will and bequeath to my
 Grand Daughter Polly Benson Daughter of George Benson
 forty pounds in Cash, if black Woman Nancy has
 other Children after this time they shall be disposed of
 in the following manner as personal property there
 with all personal property at my death shall be sold
 and equally divided among all my Children then
 living, lastly I appoint Alexander Benson and
 William Benson my Sons to be my Executors of this my
 Will and Testament, and I do hereby disannul all other
 Wills heretofore made by me, and to do by these presents
 establish this as my last will and Testament in witness
 whereof I do hereunto set my hand and Seal the twenty
 ninth Day of April one thousand eight hundred and
 twenty
