of day Branch Bath County & now State of Virginia being
infirm of body but sound of mind and calling to mind
the certainty of Death and being Desirous to dispose of my world
worldy Goods first I will recommed my Soul to God and
my Body to the Earth to be buried in certain Order by
Executors it is my will that all my just Debts & General expenses
be paid first then the rest of my Estate I give and bequeath
as follows — I will and bequeath to my Son Matthias Bownd
all the Land whereon he now lives in Pittsylvania County Vir-
ginia to him his heirs & assigns forever also I give him
our Negro man named Harry to surviving life
to him his heirs or assigns — I will and bequeath to my two
Sons Alexander Bownd & William Bownd all the Land wherow
myself and they now live to be divided as it now stands
marking before written also I give to Alexander my son one
Negro Boy named George to him his heirs or assigns during
his Life also I give to my Son William Bownd one negro
Man named Sammon to him his heirs and assigns during
Life also I give to my two Sons Alexander and William our
Plantation on Autumns Creek Cumberland County to be divided in
Equal Shares also one Tract of Land on Jacksons River Bath
County known by the Valley Land to be divided equal between
them also it is my will that my Negroes named Negro Rachel
shall have their Liberty to go to any of Children or grand
Children that they chuse to live with the remainder of them
hereafter if they shall be living after my Death Negro Lucy
and her family of Children shall be sold if they shall
be in being or not sold before my Death also I give to
my Grand Daughter Margaret Bownd Daughter of Alexander
Bownd my son one negro child named Nancy a female
to her her heirs or assigns during life I will and
bequeath to my Grand Son Matthias Bownd Son of
William Bownd my son one negro Boy named Africa

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to have his heirs or assigns during his natural life,
also I will and bequeath to my Grandson Matthias Burk-
ward Son of Elancy Burkhardt and Elizabeth Burkhardt
my Daughter and Negro Boy named Joseph to him his
heirs or assigns during life, also I will and bequeath
to my grand Daughter Margaret Benson Daughter of that
thence Benson my Son and negro Girl named Sarah
to her her heirs or assigns during life I will and bequeath
to Sarah Wily my Daughter one hundred pounds in
Bonds or Cash, also I will to Elizabeth Burkhardt one
hundred pounds in Cash or Bonds for it, also I will and
bequeath to Nelly Wright 150 pounds in Cash or
Bonds for it I will to George Benson my Son sixty pounds
in Cash or Bonds for it, I will and bequeath to my
Daughter Polly Benson Daughter of George Benson
fifty pounds in Cash, if black Woman Nancy has
other Children after this time they shall be disposed of
in the following manner as personal property then
with all personal property at my death shall be sold
and equally divided among all my Children then
living, lastly I appoint Alexander Benson and
William Benson my Sons to be my Executors of this my
Will and Testament, and I do hereby disannul all other
Wills herefore made by me, and to do by these presents do
stablish this as my last will and Testament in writing
whereof I do subscribe at my hand and Sealed this twenty
ninth Day of April one thousand eight hundred and
twenty
