The Condition of the above Obligation is such that whereas the above bound Hugh M^cGlaughlin is appointed guardian of Nancy Right of therefore the said Hugh M^cGlaughlin have well and truly secured the Estate of the said Child and indemnify the Court then the above Obligation to be void else to remain in full force.

of Bath and State of Virginia being very sick and weak
in body but of perfect mind and memory thanks be given
unto God calling unto mind the mortality of my body and
knowing that is appointed for all men once to die do make
and ordain this my last will and Testament that is to say
principally and first of all I give and recommend my
soul into the hands of Almighty God that gave it and my
body I recommend to the earth to be buried in decent Christian
burial at the direction of my executors nothing doubting but
at the general Resurrection I shall receive the same again
by the mighty power of God and as touching such ^{estate} worldly
wherein with it has pleased God to bless me with in this life
I give devise and dispose of in the following manner and
form; first I give and bequeath to Hannah my dear beloved
wife all my property together with all my household goods
debts and moveable effects as also my land during her life
for raising up the children and at her decease said land
to be equally divided between my two eldest sons viz, Isaac
and Hugh also I give to my well beloved daughter Ann one
half and also I do make and Ordain my well beloved wife
Hannah the sole executrix of this my last will and Testament
and at her decease the rest of the children to have the
property, household goods moveable effects &c all and every
except the said land, it shall be equally divided among them
and I do hereby utterly disallow revoke and discount all
and every other former Testament, wills bequests bequests and

Executors by me in any where before mentioned written or be-
queathed ^{this and as above to be my last will and Testament} saying and confirming I do hereby certify
I have set my hand and seal this fifth day of November
One thousand seven hundred and seventy eight.
