that if Richard Davis my Heirs Executors or Administrators or any of us shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said Thomas Majfie his Heirs Executors Administrators or assigns the sum of fifty Pounds Ten Shillings Together with Landfall dated from the

full day of January one thousand seven hundred and Ninety four  
and before the full day of January one thousand seven hundred and  
Ninety five and ensuing the date hereof for Exemption of the sum aforesaid  
Promised that this present Bill of Sale shall be void and of no effect  
But if sufficient be made in the payment of the said sum of Sixty One
