Provided Nevertheless that if I Richard Davis my Heirs Executors or Administrators or any of us shall well and truly pay or Cause to be paid unto the said Thomas Maffie his Heirs Executors Administrators or assigns the sum of Eighty one pounds Ten Shillings Together with Lawfull Interest from the

first day of January one thousand seven hundred and thirty four
 at or before the first day of January one thousand seven hundred &
