and conveyed and do hereby give grant and convey unto my Daughter
Leah Hutchinson one Negro Boy which will be sold in the Possession of
John M. Bartley by the Name of Dick in the following Manner to wit
Whenever my Daughter Leah shall arrive at full age then she is to have
full possession of the said Negro Boy and should she die before she
shall arrive to that age or after she shall arrive to the age aforesaid
should she Refuse to take him away then the said Negro Boy
shall be given unto my son Absalom Hutchinson clear of all Expenses
to the full use and behoof of her the said Leah or son Absalom as
the case may be Her Executors Administrators or assigns and the
said William Hutchinson for myself my Heirs Executors and
Administrators do shall and will warrant and defend the
aforesaid Negro Boy against all persons whatsoever unto the
said Leah or Absalom as the case may be Her Executors
Administrators or assigns for ever the witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and seal the six-

Named Libb, One Cow, One Large Iron Kettle, and one Negro Boy Named Dick, the
last Mentioned Negro Boy the said M. Bartley is to have the use of until the said
Hutchinsons Daughter Leah arrives to the full age and the Rest of the aforesaid property to be
invested in the said John M. Bartley his Heirs &c in as full and ample a Manner as
I my self could have had and come before the signing sealing and delivery of these
presents to the sole use and behoof of him the said John M. Bartley his Heirs Executors
Administrators or Assigns and the said William Hutchinson for my self my Heirs Executors
& Administrators do shall and will warrant and defend the aforesaid property against
all person or persons whatsoever unto the said John M. Bartley his Heirs Executors
Administrators or Assigns forever In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and seal the sixteenth day of June 1795
