 made and given constituted and appointed and
 by these presents do make and give constituted and
 appointed and truly given John A. Geer of the
 County of Warren and State of Virginia to be
 our lawful attorney for us and in our names to
 execute a deed of conveyance with William
 Douglass of Bath County and State of Virginia
 and his heirs forever of and in the right
 title and claim of a certain tract or parcel of
 land containing three hundred and fifty acres
 by Patent which John Douglass dec^d seized of
 and part being and seventh part of the above
 mentioned land lying and being in the County
 of Bath and State of Virginia in the Supar-
 tise record and we do further authorize and
