Know all men by these presents that I Thomas Cartmell of the County of Montgomery & Commonwealth of Kentucky for divers good Causes and Considerations now thence moving have nominated and appointed my trusty friend John Warrick of the County of Bath & State of Virginia my law and lawful attorney for me and in my name to convey to John Sutton a certain tract of land which I sold to a certain Thomas Anderson lying in Bath County in Virginia containing two hundred & forty three acres on the waters of Granbrier on rich land & which land as aforesaid I sold to the above mentioned Anderson and by him sold to the said Sutton and which land was not by me required to said Anderson which said Conveyance to be made by the said Warrick shall be good and valid to all intents and purposes as if I had been present and made the said Conveyance myself hereby ratifying and Confirming whatever my said Attorney shall legally do in and concerning the premises In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 16th day of September 1801
