

from the Governor under the seal of the Commonwealth dated the third day of July last past; it is therefore the said John Oliver shall well and truly collect and receive all officers fees and dues put into his hands to collect and duly account for and pay the same to the officers to whom such fees are due respectively at such times as are prescribed by law and shall well and truly execute and due return make of all process and precepts to him directed and pay and satisfy all sums of money and tobacco <sup>by him received by virtue of any such process</sup> to the person or persons to whom the same are due his or their executors administrators or assigns and in all other things shall truly and faithfully execute and perform the said office of Sheriff during the time of his continuance therein then the above obligation to be void otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
